TITLE: WITHDRAWAL OF TRANSPORTATION PRIVILEGES

1.0 OBJECTIVE

- 1.1 To encourage a safe school environment on the school vehicle through the provision of appropriate intervention measures and, when necessary, to administer disciplinary action.
- 1.2 To outline the action to be taken for student misbehavior on a school vehicle or while waiting for the vehicle.

2.0 **RESPONSIBILITY**

2.1 The school principal.

3.0 PROCEDURES

- 3.1 The driver of the school vehicle will first seek the co-operation of the student.
- 3.2 If the student does not co-operate, the driver or supervisor will report the student to the principal or designate, detailing the incidents and any corrective action taken by the driver. The Ottawa Student Transportation Authority's Bus Behavior Referral Form will be used for this purpose.
- 3.3 The principal or designate will keep a record of such incidents and take necessary corrective progressive disciplinary action, which may include withdrawal of the student's transportation privileges. In the event of withdrawal of transportation privileges, see Attachment 1.
- 3.4 For less serious offences, the following course of action may be followed:
 - a) first infraction counsel/reprimand student;
 - b) second infraction talk to student and parent/guardian, confirming actions in writing with a copy to the school bus driver; and
 - c) third (and subsequent) infraction transportation privileges withdrawn for a specified period, with notification in writing to the parent/guardian (see Attachment 1), the carrier, school bus driver, Superintendent of Instruction and

the appropriate Ottawa Student Transportation Authority Transportation Coordinator.

- 3.5 When the infraction is a serious one, the principal may proceed directly to a temporary withdrawal of school bus privileges for no more than 10 days.
- 3.6 Students will not be discharged en route to or from school as a form of corrective action for misbehavior.
- 3.7 The school vehicle is considered an extension of school property and the terms of Board Policies P.032.SCO: Safe Schools, P.020.SCO: Student Suspension, and P.026.SCO: Student Suspension/Investigation/Possible Expulsion will apply.
- 3.8 When school transportation privileges have been temporarily withdrawn, a letter (see Attachment 1) will be provided to the parent/guardian or the student, if 18 years of age or over.
- 3.9 Appeals against the temporary withdrawal of transportation privileges may be made to the Superintendent of Instruction.

Temporary Withdrawal of Transportation Privileges
